



Requirements for the Virginia Federation of Republican Women Scholarships

Thank you for your interest in applying for scholarships sponsored by the Virginia Federation of Republican Women (VFRW). Our scholarships support Republican women in their educational endeavors. To help you determine whether a VFRW scholarship is a good match for you, please note below the list of minimum qualifications:

REQUIREMENT: must be a woman with U.S. citizenship, resident of Virginia for at least two (2) years and currently attending an institution of higher learning in the Commonwealth of Virginia. Online students are not eligible for this scholarship.

REQUIREMENT: must be registered to vote in Virginia.

REQUIREMENT: must have completed a minimum of 12 hours of study at the undergraduate level and not be graduating in the current school year (i.e. 2016 – 2017).

REQUIREMENT: must have a minimum GPA of 2.5.

REQUIREMENT: must submit answers to specific essay questions contained in the application below.

REQUIREMENT: must submit one (1) letter of recommendation, from someone other than a family member, discussing the applicant's moral and ethical standing as it relates to the applicant's character

- It could be a professor or faculty member from your college or university, from a recognized (elected or appointed) Republican leader, or a respected member of the community (pastor, priest, rabbi, coach, or the like)

REQUIREMENT: A one-page resume'
