

In a survey submitted to the Bernie Sanders-linked group "Our Revolution," Fairfax supported Sanders' single-payer health care proposal. Bernie Sanders' single-payer health care proposal will end private insurance, force everyone on a government plan, and lead to a 39% increase in government spending paid for with new taxes.

Single-payer takes private insurance away from those who are happy with their health care plans. Hardworking Virginia families should not have to worry about politicians deciding which doctors they can see how they are going to pay for the \$1.38 trillion annual price tag of the Sanders plan.

While my opponent supports single-payer, I oppose it. I believe that we should pursue market-oriented solutions that allow people more freedom and choice – not limit it with a taxpayer funded government takeover. Whether introduced at the federal or state level, single-payer health care is an expensive experiment that will end private insurance, limit consumer choice, increase wait times, reduce access to specialists, and ration our health care.

Virginians face a choice about the future of health care and it could not be more clear.
