ORGANIC RECIPE:

TURKEY STROMBOLI: Ingredients: Long Italian Roll. Ground Turkey. Turkey Pepperoni. Shredded Mozzarella, Provolone, Parmigiano Reggiano Cheese. Extra Virgin Olive Oil. Pasta Sauce. Garlic and Onion Powder. Diced Green Sweet Pepper, sweet pineapple juice, black pepper and sea salt. Slice roll just to open. Take out some of the inside of roll. Rub roll with EVOO. Set aside. Cook ground turkey, add salt and black pepper. Spread Pasta Sauce on bottom of bread, layer roll with cooked turkey, sprinkle garlic powder, onion powder. add cheeses, green pepper, pepperoni and little more pasta sauce and the pineapple juice and cheeses over top. Bake on 325 for 8-10 minutes. Close roll and smash down a bit, bake another 3-5 minutes. Enjoy with a glass of white wine, or fruit drink.
