

Vote NO on these Constitutional Amendments

Ballot Question 1: the Right to Reproductive Freedom

Access to abortion is protected in Virginia. Virginia Law allows abortion throughout pregnancy. This amendment does not change that. It is political overreach that puts women's health at risk and takes away parental involvement.

What it really means:

- **Allows non-physicians to perform abortions, removing regulations that protect women**
- **Puts women's health at risk by removing health and facility safety standards**
- **Allows government to remove parental involvement in their minor child's healthcare decisions**
- **Fails to require healthcare for babies born alive after a failed abortion**

Ballot Question 2: Remove Constitutional Same-Sex Marriage Ban Amendment.

Same-sex marriage is already legal in Virginia. This amendment does nothing to change that.

What it really means:

- **Adds "gender" and "sex" as separate categories, embedding transgender ideology into our Constitution**
- **Allows transgender ideology to be used to pressure schools, businesses, and government to adopt laws that will threaten parental rights in schools and protection for girls' privacy and sports**

Ballot Question 3: the Voting Rights Restoration for Felons Upon Release Amendment

Virginia already has a process in place to restore voting rights. This amendment will restore voting rights without consideration of restitution or the offense (a convicted pedophile would be permitted to serve on a jury, vote for your school board member and even run for school board or another elected office.

What it really means:

- **Does not differentiate between violent and non-violent felonies**
- **Allows convicted violent felons to serve on juries**
- **Allows convicted violent felons to run for elected office**
